














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A COSY AND PRESERVED RESORT

Created in 1960 by shepherds, La Rosière is a personable and authentic resort with 13,950 tourist beds. Many of the establishments are still managed by the founders' children and grandchildren, who continue to welcome visitors with a family spirit. With much development over recent years, La Rosière has maintained its core identity by limiting in its development plans, the number of beds at 15,000.

SUNSHINE FOR EVERYONE

Perched on a balcony like spot, La Rosière provides a panoramic south-facing view of the Haute-Tarentaise valley. From dawn till dusk, the sun shines on and warms visitors of all ages.



GUARANTEED SNOWFALL

Located just a few kilometers from Mont Blanc and near the entrance to the Col du Petit Saint-Bernard, La Rosière benefits from favourable weather conditions. These unique characteristics ensure optimal snowfall throughout the season, which next winter will be from December 16, 2023, to April 20, 2024.

THE NEARBY DOLCE VITA

The Espace San Bernardo is a unique ski area in the northern Alps. Its 154km of ski slopes link La Rosière in France with La Thuile in Italy. Beginner or advanced skiers, freeriders or ski tourers, the Espace San Bernardo caters and adapts to all levels.

SNOW GOLF TOURNAMENTS

In March 2023, La Rosière and the Ski Domain staged the Winter Golf, a B2B event combining a snow golf tournament with roundtable discussions focusing on shared environmental challenges between golf and skiing: water management, resource utilization, economic models. Building upon the success of this event, La Rosière will host a snow golf tournament every month, open to visitors. Accomplished golfers and curious newcomers alike will have the chance to discover a novel way of playing golf.

ACCOMMODATION

A RETREAT AT THE BOTTOM OF THE SLOPES WITH THE LODGE DES GLACIERS

Following a swift 7-month construction project, Altitude Résidence opens its Lodge des Glaciers in December 2023. Located in the heart of the resort, 100m from the central snowfront and with doorstep skiing guaranteed (being able to return by skis directly), this residence comprises of 11 apartments accommodating 4 to 18 individuals, with a total capacity of 103 beds. Blending traditional charm with modern materials, the units are aimed at 4-star classification. Services such as grocery delivery and in-home massages ensure a memorable stay at the Lodge. AN ALTERNATIVE LUXURY EXPERIENCE WITH THE CLUB MED EXCLUSIVE COLLECTION

Launched in 2021, the 4-Trident Club Med in La Rosière boasts 918 beds. At start of winter, the Club will inaugurate its Exclusive Collection 5-Trident extension, introducing 43 suite-apartments, thereby adding 150 additional beds. The interior design of these suites, all of which are high-end, reinterprets the artisanal elements of the region of La Thuile in the Aosta Valley, where a tradition of lacemaking has existed since the 17th century. For visitors, the Exclusive Collection provides a unique experience: a totally dedicated team for the Exclusive Collection Space, a readily available concierge service, assistance with reservations in the resort, its own welcome lounge with bar and snacking services, champagne from 6pm. LE TERROIR DES VIGNOBLES :

In the winter of 2023, Judith, a local native, and her husband Alexandre unveiled high-end establishment. Both hailing from the renowned Restaurant Le Chabichou in Courchevel (a 2-star Michelin guide restaurant), Judith and Alexandre offer a refined menu in a cozy and minimalist setting. Alexandre has curated a selection of "hidden gem" wines from small producers and works on the starters and main courses in the kitchen. As the pastry chef, Judith concludes the meal with skilfully crafted and original desserts. Mentioned in the Gault&Millau (renowned French restaurant guide) website just a few months after its opening, Judith and Alexandre have established a true dining experience at accessible prices. Reservations are recommended (09 81 50 38 02), as the 30 seats fill up quickly! As a bonus, all wines from the menu are available in the cellar, for a takeaway tasting.



With 17 years of experience in the resort, Marc Pirard, former coach of the French ski teams, has opened the "Olympic Sports&Café" shop on the central snowfront. This 280m² space offers rental and equipment sales services, an "express waxing-sharpening" workshop, and ski storage, all provided by a team of passionate experts and talented boot fitters equipped with the latest gear. It's the "Café" aspect that truly adds character to this space, aiming to make it a genuine hub for socializing and interaction. Throughout the day, locally sourced homemade meals will be available quickly to customers. Events will enliven the season, including free ski tests every week, film screenings, themed nights, and après-ski music sessions. In partnership with the off-piste division of the ESF (French Ski School), every week visitors will receive information about off-piste conditions and safety measures for the week.

AMENITIES

PRODUCTIONS IN THE WOODS AT THE FOREST THEATRE

Here is performance venue, which is perfectly integrated with nature and blends seamlessly into its surroundings. The Forest Theatre of La Rosière has been built right in the heart of the Forest Trail, connecting the two districts of the resort, without felling a single tree. Constructed entirely from larch wood, a durable local timber, and without any concrete, it stands as a testament to sustainability. Its wooden foundations are securely anchored several meters deep. With a capacity of up to 200 people, it hosts a diverse range of events: concerts, shows, open-air cinema... You can even have your wedding here!

TOP MEETING

At the **PARADIS** Restaurant, professionals can enjoy a seminar room with a view, fully equipped for conferences or work sessions, at an altitude of 2000 meters, in the middle of the ski slopes. Accessible by ski or on foot. Privatization and catering upon request. Max. 35 people.

REVAMPED BEGINNERS' SNOWFRONT

This winter, the beginners' snow front in the Les Eucherts area is getting a makeover with the replacement of the Dahu drag lift with a 4-seater fixed chairlift. This significant upgrade is especially beneficial for beginners. After the initial action on the Lutins carpet, beginners can now smoothly progress to the Dahu chairlift. By reducing its footprint on the Eucherts snowfront, this new lift will allow wider access to the two green and two blue slopes in the area. Additionally, public toilets will be accessible at the departure point.



WITH THE « CARTE BLANCHE », POSSIBLE ON FOOT AND WITH KIDS

The "Carte Blanche" allows non-skiers to enjoy a wide range of non-ski activities offered by the resort. At the fixed rate of 38€, it provides unlimited pedestrian-snowshoe access to the ski lifts for 1 day, entry to the ice rink, a cinema ticket, an X'treme sledge ride, and an introductory session of Laser Game or Paintball.

As for the youngest visitors, children under 5 years old are entitled to a complimentary pass for the French part of the Ski Domain, upon proof of age (+2€ for the magnetic card).

FRILUTSLIV. WHAT'S THAT?

The mountainsides, the great outdoors, landscapes. Tranquillity, sounds muffled by snow. La Rosière is also the perfect place for those seeking disconnection, a return to nature, a personal haven. Depending on what you're looking for, there are two scenarios: embracing frilutsliv, the Norwegian art of fully enjoying the fresh air outdoors and finding rejuvenation in the cold. Alternatively, indulging in relaxation and treatments within the warm atmospheres of La Rosière's spas.

THE RIDGE, ON SNOWSHOES

La Rosière offers around 27 km of hiking trails, accessible on foot or with snowshoes, of which 12 km are groomed and prepared. Craving some fresh air? Purchase a pedestrian pass (€18/adult) and enjoy unlimited access to 5 ski lifts. For example, start leisurely from the Les Eucherts area on a 3-kilometer groomed trail, heading towards the Fort chairlift that takes you effortlessly up to 2390m in altitude. At the summit, soak in the view with some mulled wine before returning to the Roc Noir slope along the ridge for 3.4 kilometres. If you have any energy left, you can descend for 6 kilometres. If your thighs start to burn a bit too much, take the Roches Noires chairlift back: it will bring you directly to the Centre's snow front for a well-deserved gourmet break at Josie La Folie

With the Guides and Accompanists Office of La Rosière, you can also embark on guided excursions to explore the trails safely. As a bonus, you'll receive a wealth of advice and a history lesson about the region.



SKI TOURING FOR EVERYONE

An evening dedicated to ski touring. Every Tuesday, experience a night-time introduction to ski touring with La Rosière's ski schools (Oxygène, OriginAlps, Evolution2 and ESF). Learn to apply climbing skins, manage your energy, and optimize your efforts: instructors teach participants the fundamental techniques of this sport. As an added bonus: a magnificent sunset over the valley and a Savoyard snack in the forest. From €25.

PLAYFUL SKIING WITH EVOLUTION 2

Recognising that children's skiing experiences should be unique, Evolution 2 is introducing a playful component to its group lessons for children this year. Beginner children will take part in an outdoor escape game on the ski slopes during their week, led and guided by their ski instructor. Other more advanced groups will immerse themselves in the daily activities of the ski patrollers, participating with them in opening the slopes.

XTreme Luge:

Experience the year-round luge of La Rosière. Mounted on a rail, the sledge zooms down the slopes of La Rosière, giving thrills for about 1 min 30 seconds. You control the speed, limited to 45 km/h. Even the youngest, starting from 2 years old, can try it out, accompanied by an adult, of course. €69 for 10 descents (summer 2023 rates)




YOONER, PARET, SNAKE-GLISS

When the slopes close, your final descent can be done in a much less conventional manner: try the "paret" with Evolution2 or the "yooner" and "snake-gliss" with ESF. The "paret" is a traditional single-blade sled, while the "yooner" represents its modern evolution. As for the "snake-gliss," it's an assembly of sleds (up to 10) sliding down the slopes, weaving through the trails like a snake. A superb way to end a day!







FOR DRINKS AND PARTYING

La Rosière is a family-oriented resort with a serene atmosphere, perfect for quality time with family and friends. But don't be mistaken, you can also let your hair down!

On the slopes, visitors can discover **L'Antigel**, a high-altitude bar/restaurant that hosts lively afternoons with a DJ every week. You can dance without even taking off your ski boots, all while enjoying a magnificent view of the valley, warmed by the rays of the setting sun.

INDULGE IN CULINARY DELIGHTS

Just as the ski area offers something for every taste, La Rosière's restaurants follow the same principle.

On the slopes, **PARADiS** offers meticulously prepared cuisine crafted from local products. Vegetarians can savour the Mère Maury's ravioli gratin. The slow-cooked pork rib will delight meat lovers.


SAFETY SHRED DAYS

The largest French freeride gathering returns to La Rosière for the third year from the 10th to 14th of January. Presented by Victor Daviet, pro rider for Salomon, this event offers the general public an awareness and training program on mountain risks and rescue operations. In 2023, about 200 individuals were trained and educated through this event.

In a relaxed atmosphere, participants will be trained in avalanche victim search techniques by professionals from ANENA (French National Agency for the Study of Snow and Avalanches) as well as prominent figures in snowboarding (Victor De Le Rue, Thomas Delfino, Marion Haerty). Alongside, the days will be also filled with conferences, snow simulation workshops, and a banked slalom.






CARNIVAL

CM@THE TOP



WINTER GOLF AND ROUND TABLES OF LA ROSIÈRE

Due to its resounding success, this unique event returns for its second edition on Thursday, March 28, 2024. La Rosière's 9-hole snow-covered golf course opens for a scramble tournament featuring teams of two players. In the afternoon there are round table discussions on key mountain-related topics promising an enriching exchange between experts and participants.

The Bands-Camp Academy returns to La Rosière for a week of 100% music. SCÉNARIO A : FIRST TRACK AND FRIENDSHIPS

8:30am: It's Tuesday, time for the First Track. Meet at the base of the Eucherts chairlift half an hour before the resort opens at 9 AM. Hop on and enjoy two or three runs, alone with a few privileged skiers. The mountain is just waking up, and all you hear is the sound of skis on the freshly groomed snow.

After a few runs, it's time for a break at PARADIS. Included in the First Track package is the chance to refuel for the morning. A coffee, a pastry, and a glass of orange juice, all with a sublime view.

Hunger strikes. Stop at L'Antigel, a slope-side mountain restaurant near the Tétras run. Corinne, Didier, and their team welcome you into this spacious chalet with an enticing menu. Indulge in the Beaufort cheeseburger – a true delight!

2pm: Back on the slopes for a few runs to help with digestion. The sun is still high, making it a perfect time for a photo on the Panoramic footbridge. This metal bridge is located above a precipice at the fort. Swipe your lift pass at the terminal, the camera takes the picture, and you receive it via email a few minutes later.

The day has been busy, and you've now got the urge to hang up your skis. Back in the village, have a drink at the Via Ferrata to share the day's moments and check out each other's photos.

5pm: Head to the Xtreme Luge for some final thrills. At 45 km/h, the twists and turns are exhilarating, as you can hear from the screams and shouts.

It's fondue night! Stop by Odile's place, Aux Délices Fermiers, to buy the cheese, some Savoie white wine, and a bit of charcuterie. For bread, head to the Ledemé bakery just above.

10pm: With a full belly and a happy heart, it's time to rest. The week's holidays have only just begun!





SCÉNARIO B : BENVENUTO IN ITALIA

9am: Skiing across a border? Today's the day! Strap on your skis and head to the Eucherts chairlift. After a few warm-up runs, make your way to the Fort de la Redoute Ruinée to admire the historic military building and the view of Mont-Blanc.

From the fort, head to the north face of the mountain, towards the Bellecombe drag lifts, which will take you to the Italian border. Make the most of these as they are among the last drag lifts still running in the Haute-Tarentaise.

Italia! Beautiful slopes await you amidst the fir and larch trees. You'll sense a different ambiance, a new feel in the air.

12pm: At the snowfront of La Thuile, head for shuttle for Chez Pepita, the restaurant just 600 meters away. Indulge in one of their delicious pizzas. Don't miss their divine tiramisu, and finish with the local digestif: limoncello cream in a chocolate cup!

After a quick shuttle ride back, take the La Thuile gondola to reach the upper areas of the Italian resort.

3pm: Back in France. The sun bathes the entire mountainside, and you leisurely glide down the wide French slopes, heading towards the hotel.

After all this effort deserves some reward: a 30-minute massage at the hotel's spa to relax all your muscles. Shed off any remaining fatigue in the hammam.

Free time over, head to the Terroir des Vignobles to discover their menu curated by Judith and Alexandre. Surprising starters, elaborate main courses, sumptuous desserts, all accompanied by an impressive wine selection – it's hard to find a better way to end the day!

THE ALPS ONA BUDGET LA ROSIÈRE'S MONEY-SAVING TIPS

"Winter sports are expensive!" Yes, they can be! But... with a little effort in finding the right deals, there are several options to make the most of your budget and enjoy what La Rosière has to offer.

TRAFFIC TIPS:

The X-Periences pass combines several activities. Consider staying from Sunday to Sunday. If you arrive and depart on Sundays, you should encounter much smoother traffic conditions for driving, sometimes lower rates and less people on the pistes on the Saturday. THE XPERIENCES PASS

The Xperiences Pass combines a variety of activities. 
